The meeting was called to order at 7:13pm by President Taryn Cox.

- The minutes from the February meeting were reviewed. A motion to accept the minutes was made by Rob Frazier, seconded by Nati Jolivet, and passed unanimously.

Treasurer's Report – Taryn Cox for Amanda Merriam

- The current balance as of 02/26/24 is \$16,341.26. In & Outs currently in the account – contest solos/duets and contest team meals.
 - The Judges' stage came in under the projected amount at \$1022.50. A HUGE thank you to the team that built it, installed it, and uninstalled it the night of the event. It was a very classy look for our school and seemed to be quite comfortable for the judges.
 - Concessions tripled last year's host contest net revenue at \$3564.81.
 - Team meals went well. As a side note, we need to plan for waters for those team meals next year (\$48.24)
 - Vendors brought in \$270 in additional revenue and offered a nice shopping experience for parents.
 - Custodial services were an expense of \$300.
 - Hospitality Room and Booster/Spur Room expenses were \$816.93. Serving approximately 120 people 3 meals/day with snacks averaged \$2.30/meal/person.
 - We are still waiting on revenues from Ascension. Last year was just under 6K.
 - Comments/Suggestions voiced:
 - Bringing in more Rookie parents to serve alongside Committee Chairs
 - Breaking up Assignments (have Chair & CoChair split the coverage throughout the day)
 - Make sure spectators know the café is open to everyone (consider a smaller, 2nd concessions area in café)

New Business – Taryn Cox

- VOTE: With the Spurs program growing, the team contest entry fees were higher. As such, there was a shortfall in regard to Officer Camp. \$1210. was requested to cover registration/meals. A motion to approve this expense was made by Paul Cox, seconded by Kimberly Tucker, and passed unanimously.
- State Contest in Frisco. Previously approved expense of hotel stay and dinner (approx. \$1500). LBHS will have a State Sendoff for the girls at 9:30 at LBHS. All parents and fans are invited and encouraged to come out, be loud, and send the team off in style.
- Spring Show is coming up after 5th Line Tryouts. More info to come. Be looking for program ad interest link.

Spurs may invite family and friends; tickets must be purchased for \$25 per person. Assistance will be requested for set-up the day of the event.
