Treasurer's Report – Amanda Merriam

- The current balance as of 10/03/23 is \$41,886.21. Booster account serves as an in-and-out account for several occasions (ie: team gear, Friday meals, contest fees, etc) and may not currently accurately reflect the club balance. There will be a large expense in October for the trailer wrap (approximately \$4,000). A link to the report is on the Boosters' page of the website.

- Trailer Wrap Completion and Reveal: The trailer is complete and ready to be revealed. The plan is to have the Spurs meet Wednesday, October 4th, in the studio at 5pm to “prep for the 212 Boil” and have the trailer pull in the bus loop in front of the school. Parents are welcome to attend.
- Tongue Lock must be purchased \$75 – vote: A motion to approve this expense was made by Kimberly Tucker, seconded by Brian Williams, and passed unanimously.
- Insurance must be completed. When being towed, the trailer will be covered by the driver's insurance. However, we are required to have insurance to cover it when parked. Awaiting quote from Extraco. A suggestion was also made to reach out to Mike Diaz (Spur sponsor and Allstate agent).
- Annual Fundraiser Update
 - Kona Ice – will remain Spurs Sponsor. Total YTD \$350 with 2 more games.
 - T-shirt sales with REDS have concluded. Our profit \$300
 - HOCO Photo Buttons - \$10 each via JotForm/Square and will be distributed 10/4 at 212 event.
